## (I) Duties of teachers in charge of morning reading

1. Students have to finish reading books or reading materials in different scopes according to the Morning Reading Time-table as shown in Table 1.
2. The Reading Programme will **start from 13<sup>rd</sup> September**. If students don't have English newspaper on Thursday in September, they should read the thematic books of Pursuing a Joyful and Purposeful Life / Learning to Learn according to Table 1.
3. Students have to read at least **ONE book for each theme**. They are required to finish the relevant library reading report or works.
4. S1 students have to read English newspaper on Thursday. They need to write down those vocabularies they do not know on **Vocabulary Book**.
5. S1 students have to read several selected Chinese articles on Friday. They will have a **reading assessment** related to the selected articles given by the Chinese Language Department every time. The assessments will be **collected by Chinese teachers**.
6. Every student has at least **ONE reading sharing** in each term. Top 4 students in class will be awarded \$20 book coupon.
7. There is a Free Reading Month in May. Students can choose any scope of books they want to read provided that the contents of the books are healthy and those books are borrowed from school library or public libraries.
8. Morning reading teachers are required to monitor students to read the reading materials according to the Morning Reading Scheme time table. Students should keep quiet and concentrate on their reading.
9. Five library lessons will be conducted from September as shown in Table 2.
