2. The Reading Program will **start from 16<sup>th</sup> September**.
3. Students have to read **at least ONE book for each theme**.
4. S1 students have to read English newspaper in October. They need to write down those vocabularies they do not know on **Vocabulary Book**.
5. S1 students have to read several selected Chinese articles in November to December. They will have a **reading assessment** related to the selected articles given by the Chinese Language Department. The assessments will be **collected by Chinese teachers**.
6. Every student has at least **ONE reading sharing** in each term. Top 4 students in class will be awarded \$20 book coupon.
7. There is a Free Reading Month in September. Students can choose any scope of books they want to read provided that the contents of the books are healthy and those books are **borrowed from school library or public libraries**.
8. Morning reading teachers are required to monitor students to read the reading materials according to the Morning Reading Scheme time table. Students should keep quiet and concentrate on their reading.
9. Four library lessons will be conducted from September as shown in Table 2.
